Code of Conduct - Students

We are fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all students, members, and staff. To ensure classes are safe, respectful, and enjoyable, students are expected to follow this Code of Conduct at all times.

Behaviour & Respect

- Follow the rules and respect teachers, staff, and their decisions.
 - Show respect towards fellow students at all times.
 - Do not distract, bully, or harass others during class.
 - Always be polite, use good manners, and avoid bad language.
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Attendance & Punctuality

- Arrive on time for classes. If late, inform the teacher.
 - Attend regularly and be ready to participate with focus and effort.
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Uniform & Presentation

- Wear the correct uniform/appropriate clothing for all classes.
 - Remove all body jewellery before class.
 - Long hair must be tied back in a bun.
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Safety & Responsibility

- Treat all equipment with care and respect.
- Inform the teacher before warm-up if you have an injury or illness.
- Let the teacher know immediately if you feel unwell or injured during class.
- Food, drink, and chewing gum are not allowed in the studio. Only water in a named bottle is permitted.
- Place all litter in the bins provided.

- Leave valuables at home — Dance Projection cannot be responsible for lost items.
 - Switch off mobile phones and electronic devices during class.
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Attitude & Enjoyment

- Enter class with a positive attitude and a smile.
 - Work hard, support others, and remember that dance should be fun!
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Disciplinary Procedure

- Students breaching this Code will be reminded of the rules.
 - Repeated breaches may result in being asked to sit out of class.
 - Continued issues will lead to parents being informed by the teacher.
 - If no improvement is seen, parents will be invited to meet with the teacher to discuss behaviour and agree next steps.
 - In extreme cases (e.g., physical violence, verbal abuse, or intentional damage to property), parents will be contacted immediately, and suspension or exclusion from classes may be considered.
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 Following this Code ensures a safe, respectful, and enjoyable environment for all dancers.
